

Chinese New Year Memory Matching Game

1. Print two pages of playing cards.
2. Paste each sheet to a piece of construction paper or cardstock.
3. Cut out individual cards.

To Play:

1. Shuffle cards and place face down on a table in rows.
2. Each player takes one card.
3. Players take turns choosing a card from the table. If they choose a match, the pair of cards is placed aside until the end of the game. Player chooses another card for the next round. If the card is not a match, the player returns the card to the original spot.
4. The player with the most matches at the end of the game wins.
5. *Optional bonus point to the player that matches the featured animal of the year.
