

## Bubble Blowing Tube

### Materials:

Cardboard tube

Dish soap

Bowl

Dip the end of a cardboard tube into a puddle of dish soap. Blow lightly through the opposite end to make some extra large bubbles.

## Kazoo Tube

### Materials:

Cardboard tube

3-inch square piece of waxed paper

Rubber band

Color the cardboard tube if you wish. Use a rubber band to hold the waxed paper in place on one end of the tube. Blow through the opposite end. Experiment to find different ways you can make sounds.

## Fireworks Stamping Tube

### Materials:

Cardboard tube

Scissors

Paints

Paper

Make a drawing of your home or city. Add fireworks by cutting strips on one end of the cardboard tube. Bend the strips outward to make a firework shape. Dip in your favorite color paints or choose red, white and blue for Fourth-of-July. Add fireworks to your drawing.
